Payment of 2024 EPA and FDEP Demand for SSO Stipulated Penalties

#### Dear Sir or Madam:

Miami-Dade County (County) received a Demand for Stipulated Penalties letter from the United Stated Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) dated September 8, 2025. Based on the Quarterly Reports submitted to United Stated Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and FDEP pursuant Section IX, Paragraph 32 of the Consent Decree (CD) for the reporting period of January 1, 2024 and June 30, 2024, EPA and FDEP elected to assess stipulated penalties for eighteen (18) Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) of 1,000 gallons or more that reached waters of the United States. EPA and FDEP assessed stipulated penalties pursuant to Section X, Subparagraphs 42.(a)(i) through (v) and the Order Modifying Section X (Document 156) of the CD in the amount of \$32,000.

The County paid \$16,000 (50%) of the stipulated Penalty to EPA and \$16,000 (50%) to FDEP for the total amount of \$32,000. As required, the County disbursed a \$16,000 payment via electronic fund transfer (EFT) to EPA and a \$16,000 Check to the FDEP.



In accordance with Section X, Paragraphs 44 and 46 of the CD, the County is required to submit proof of payment within 30 days of the written demand for stipulated penalties. Please find copies of the EFT transaction records and the check to FDEP attached herein.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering such information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.


