Dear Sir or Madam:

Miami-Dade County (County) received the Amended Demand for Stipulated Penalties letter dated October 28, 2024, stating that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) were assessing stipulated penalties pursuant to Section X, Paragraph 42(a) and the Order Modifying Section X of the Consent Decree (Document 156) in the amount of \$49,000. EPA and FDEP assessed penalties for twenty-eight (28) Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO) that reached the waters of the United States between January 1, 2021, and December 31, 2023 for a total of amount of \$49,000.

In accordance with the provisions of Paragraph 44 of the above referenced Consent Decree (CD), the County shall pay the stipulated penalties within 30 days of receipt of the Amended Demand for Stipulated Penalties letter to EPA and FDEP. The County paid \$24,500 (50%) of the stipulated penalty to EPA and \$24,500 (50%) of the stipulated penalty to FDEP for the total amount of \$49,500. As required, the County disbursed \$24,500 payment

via electronic fund transfer (EFT) to EPA and a \$24,500 payment via check to the FDEP. The Check was sent via certified mail.

In accordance with Section X, Paragraphs 44 and 46 of the CD, the County is required to submit proof of payment within thirty (30) days of the written demand for stipulated penalties. Please find copies of the EFT transaction records and a copy of the check to FDEP attached herein.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted. Based on my inquiry of the person or persons who manage the system, or those persons directly responsible for gathering such information, the information submitted is, to the best of my knowledge and belief, true, accurate and complete. I am aware that there are significant penalties for submitting false information, including the possibility of fine and imprisonment for knowing violations.


