### Dear Sir/Madam:

On April 20, 2021, Miami-Dade County (County) received a Demand for Stipulated Penalties letter from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP). County Quarterly Reports submitted to EPA and FDEP pursuant Section IX, Paragraph 32 of the Consent Decree (CD) between January 1, 2020 and December 31, 2020 included (21) twenty-one Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSOs) of 1,000 gallons or more that did not reach waters of the United States. FDEP assessed stipulated penalties pursuant to Section X, Subparagraphs 42.(a)(i) through (v) and the Order Modifying Section X (Document 156) of the CD in the amount of \$83,500 for these (21) twenty-one (21) SSO events that did not reach waters of the United States and were subject to stipulated penalties.

On June 2, 2021, FDEP granted the County a time-extension for the payment of the stipulated penalties to June 12, 2021 due revisions made to the original letter. As required, the County disbursed an \$83,500 check to the FDEP and will be sent via certified mail. Please find a copy of the check to FDEP attached herein.

In accordance with Section X, Paragraph 44 and 46 of the above referenced CD, the County is required to submit proof of payment within thirty (30) days of the written demand for the stipulated penalties. Please find a copy of the check to FDEP attached herein.


