Dear Sir or Madam:

The purpose of this letter is to request that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) waive potential stipulated penalties, if any, associated with delays to project completion of Consent Decree (CD) Capital Improvement Project (CIP) 5.5 – Replacement of Switchgear and Rehabilitation of Wet Well Pump Station No. 0415 at 3750 NW 181st Street, Miami Gardens, Florida (the "Project"). The original CD description for CD 5.5 was replacement of electrical switchgear and rehabilitation of the wet well to include an odor control unit. The construction project scope included the rehabilitation and replacement of all equipment including pumps, motors, electrical equipment, HVAC, odor control, valves, piping and wet well.

On October 2, 2019, the County submitted a Failure to Meet Compliance Date Notification for CD CIP 5.5 (see Exhibit A attached hereto). The Project experienced delays during the construction and commissioning phases that impacted the compliance date of September 2, 2019. The Project reached the construction completion milestone on November 13, 2019 (see Exhibit B attached hereto).

During the commissioning of the Project, the authorized equipment manufacturer's representatives and electrical equipment testing subcontractor were delayed in performing equipment and electrical inspections and certifying the instrumentation, equipment controls and electrical components. The authorized representatives and electrical subcontractor were not available in a timely manner due to workload. A copy of the Performance Testing Sign Off Sheets for various equipment, the Manufacturer's Certification of Proper Installation, and the Start-Up Sign Off Sheet for Grounding obtained during the Performance Testing Period are attached hereto as Exhibit C.

The County took the following actions to mitigate the Project delays:

- Increased frequency of meetings with the Contractor and the authorized equipment manufacturer's representatives to track updates on the pending Substantial Completion items;
- Provided dedicated Pump Station Division staff during performance testing and equipment inspection so that immediate adjustments could be made to expedite testing;
- Provided additional work resources to expedite key activities; and
- Prioritized work and review of the Performance Testing Sign-Off Sheets by the Engineer of Record.

As a result of the continued efforts to closely monitor the Project status, Substantial Completion was achieved 72-days after the CD compliance date of September 2, 2019.

Section X, Paragraph 44 of the Consent Decree states: "Either sovereign may waive stipulated penalties or reduce the amount of stipulated penalties it demands, in the unreviewable exercise of its discretion and in accordance with this Paragraph 44." The County respectfully requests that EPA and FDEP use their discretion to waive potential stipulated penalties, if any, associated with this Project because the County has been transparent in communicating the hardships encountered on this Project and took mitigating steps to limit the Project delays as much as possible. It is the County's belief that any stipulated penalties assessed due to Project delays would be better invested toward additional improvements to the system.


